

of the London Committee, to give employment to the poor in that time of scarcity. It runs from the east, about a mile in length, towards Clover-hill, in a circular direction to the south west. Its situation commands a fine prospect of the town, river, &c. and by a little spirited exertion, it might be made a very delightful ride or drive, besides being devoted to other purposes of utility. The county of Sligo returns two members to Parliament; the present are Edward S. Cooper, esq. of Marreea Castle, near Colomey, and the Hon. Henry King, whose residence is chiefly in London; Owen Wynne, esq. of Hazle-

wood, is member for the town. The market days for butter and grain are Tuesday and Friday, and, besides, a general market is held on Saturdays. According to the official returns, with which we have been politely favoured by authority, Sligo contains, in the parish of St. John, 1718 houses and 9993 inhabitants, and in the parish of Calry, 581 houses and 3225 inhabitants, making in the whole (according to the census of 1821) 2299 houses, and a population of 13218, but the number of inhabitants, now resident in the town, is generally considered to be much greater than the amount then returned.
