POST OFFICE, Day-place.—*Post Master*, Lieutenant Busted. Mails from Dublin, Limerick, Listowel, Rathkeale, and Turbert, arrive at six minutes past twelve every day, and depart at five every morning. Mails from Cork, Killarney, Mill-Street and Macroom, arrive at half-past seven every evening, and depart at half-past four every morning. The Mail from Mill-Town and Castle-Island, arrives every Monday, Thursday and Saturday morning at eight, and is despatched on the same mornings at half-past twelve. A mail from Dingle arrives at six every evening, and departs at half-past twelve every morning. The mail from Kenmare, arrives every Monday, Thursday and Saturday, at half-past seven, and departs at half past four on the same days.
