COACHES.

FROM THE COACH OFFICE, MEETING-
HOUSE-LANE.

BELFAST and DUBLIN, the Royal
Mail at 20 minutes past eleven at
night, through Ballymouney, Bally-
mena, Randlestown and Antrim.

BELFAST, the Champion, on Sundays,
Tuesdays and Thursdays, at six in the
morning, and returns on Mond. Wed.
and Fridays, at six in the evening.

BELFAST, the Champion Day Coach, at
six in the morning, on Sundays,
Tuesdays and Thursdays, and return
on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays
at six in the evening.

LONDONDERRY, the Royal Mail,
through Newtownlimavady, at nine at
night.

There are no regular carriers for the
conveyance of goods, but cars can be
hired for the purpose.

COMBER

It is a neat little town in the county of Down, 87 miles
north of Dublin, 14 north of Downpatrick, 11 south
west of Donaghadee, and 8 south east of Belfast.
The church, a comely structure, is part of what for-
merly constituted the cathedral of St. Mary's Abbey.
The Rev. George Birch is rector of the parish; the
curacy is inappropriate. There are also one Presby-
terian and one Methodist chapel. Facilities of edu-
cation are afforded to 120 poor children by the estab-
lishment of a school on the Lancasterian plan, under
the auspices of the Londonderry family. A second
school was founded in 1813 by Viscountess Castle-

reagh, and the trustees of Erasmus Smyth, for the
education of an unlimited number of all persuasions.
The House of Industry, very recently founded, is libe-
rally supported by the inhabitants of the town and
neighbourhood. From this establishment flax is dis-
tributed upon terms, which operate strongly as a sti-
mulus to industry in the lower order of society.
There is also a farming society for the encouragement
of agriculture, at the meetings of which industry and
successful perseverance do not fail to meet with just
rewards. The population is nearly 1,000.

POST OFFICE, Church-street.—*Post Mistress,* Mrs. Ann O'Neill. The mail for Dublin and all
by-roads, is despatched every day, except Saturday, at eight in the morning, and arrives at twenty minutes
before three in the afternoon. The mail for Belfast leaves at a quarter before three in the afternoon, and
arrives at fifteen minutes past eight in the morning.
