STRANGFORD,

IN the county of Down, is a small town pleasantly situated at the entrance of the beautiful Lough of the same name, with a good harbour for vessels of small burden. Here are a number of good houses, an excellent inn, and the ruins of an old castle. The Custom-house is situated on the quay, whence there is a charming prospect of Portaferry and of the surrounding country. This town is the property of Lord Henry Fitzgerald. Here is a charter school very

liberally endowed by Robert Earl of Kildare. About a mile distant is the beautiful demesne of Castle-Ward, the residence of Lord Viscount Bangor, which for elegance, and the beauty of its park and gardens, is exceeded by few in the kingdom. There is a large fair held in Strangford on the 12th of August which lasts three days, and another on the 8th of November.
