Banbridge, Castlebellingham, Dromore, Dunleer, Lisburne and Belfast, Drogheda, Dundalk, Hillsborough, Newry.

Bags are also made up with British, Foreign, and State Letters, on Sundays, for all six-day posts. The Cork Mail Coaches are despatched as follows, one by Clonmel, at seven each evening, and the other by Cashel, at seven each morning.

All Double, Treble, and other Letters and Packets whatever, pay in proportion to the respective rates, of Single Letters. Packets chargeable by Weight pay after the rate of four Single Letters for every ounce, and so in proportion for any greater weight, reckoning every quarter of an ounce equal to a Single Letter.

EAST INDIES.—All Letters to the Cape of Good Hope, the Mauritius, Ceylon, and the East Indies, which may be sent through the Post Office, are liable to a Sea Postage of twopence each, under the weight of three ounces, and one shilling per ounce if above that weight, in addition to the inland rates to London, to be paid at the time of putting in the Letter.
