DUBLIN, the Cork Mail, from Cork Mail Office, Patrick street, through Carlow and Naas, every evening at eight.

KINNEGAD

Is a small but very neat post town, thirty miles west of Dublin, nine south-east of Mullingar, fourteen south west of Trim, and fifteen west of Killeock, in the county of West Meath. It is on the high road to Galway and Sligo, which divides at the west end of the town. A very neat stone church is now erecting. Within the precincts of the town may also be seen a convenient Catholic chapel, a good market-house, a parochial school, and a dispensary supported by subscription. Kinnegad also contains two extensive inns; that which is known by the name of Hoy's, is, for accommodation, surpassed by few in the kingdom. The market day is Wednesday, and three fairs are held in the year, viz: on the 9th of May, the 2nd of July, and the 9th of October. Population about 400.

POST OFFICE.—Post Master, Mr. Samuel Campbell. The Dublin Mail is despatched at half-past twelve at night, by the Galway Mail, and returns at twenty minutes past one in the morning. The Sligo Mail is despatched at thirty-four minutes past one in the morning. The Castletown-Delvin bags go by horse at six in the morning, and return at eight at night.
